READING AND COUNTING TO SUCCESS PLUS (RACS+)

The RACS+ Program is an after-school program and summer camp for children between the ages of 5-17. The program provides homework assistance and tutoring in reading and math and field trips. Students also practice social-emotional learning skills that focuses on improving their confidence and self-esteem.

N-TOUCH READY 4 REAL LIFE

The N-Touch program is for middle and high school aged youth who meet twice a month to discuss Job skills, Adulting (Life Skills), Schooling (Education), and Health. We focus on helping youth graduate high school on time, gain post-secondary employment, further expand education, or credentials, develop soft skills, and improve self-esteem, self-control, mood and critical thinking.



PARENTING FROM WITHIN (PFW)

Is a 10-week parenting class for incarcerated mothers. These sessions take place within the Genesee County Jail on Tuesdays & Wednesdays at 1pm as well as throughout the week in office at times that are convenient for the client.

Topics include- Rewards, Communication & Family Meetings, Healthy Relationships, Reentry, Job Readiness, Setting Boundaries, Solving Problems & Giving Directions, Goals & Objectives, Emotional Regulation, and more.

FATHERING OUR CHILDREN WITH UNCONDITIONAL SUPPORT (F.O.C.U.S)

Is a 12-week program that focus on building a man's self-confidence, communication skills, and fathering techniques that will help improve his personal relationships. F.O.C.U.S helps identify problems within self to then rebuild for a stable core and structural life.

SOCIAL CONNECTION SUPPORT GROUP

Is a 10-week program that is offered to the mothers and fathers who has completed our parenting classes. This group helps the parents prepare for re-entry. They focus on resources, goal setting, boundaries, resume building, work ethic, decision making and social emotional learning.

HEALTHCARE ENROLLMENT

Referrals and assistance with enrollment for healthcare coverage through the Genesee Health Plan for incarcerated people and their families.
